

CSGA CANBERRA 9-HOLE CHALLENGE CONDITIONS – 2022

Cheryl Lane Trophy

The 2022 Canberra 9-Hole Challenge will be held over three rounds, commencing 8th August. **The games are to be played on Monday mornings, commencing about 10.00am for each round. The format of play will be Stableford.**

Playing conditions

Each team is to consist of four players, preferably who play in their club's 9-hole competition, in the handicap range of GA 30 to 54.

Exception: One player can be on a GA handicap no lower than 26.

Other players within the stated handicap range may participate to make up the numbers.

Players must not have played in any CSGA pennant team in the current year.

If a club is unable to field a full team, composite teams are allowed. Clubs must nominate a composite team prior to commencement.

Carts are permitted without a Medical Certificate. No caddies are allowed.

Team members may be alternated if a club has sufficient players; ie the same players don't have to make up the team each week. This is a chance for players to represent their club, particularly those who do not play pennants or who feel as though they aren't competitive enough. The idea is to help inexperienced and 9-hole golfers play on other courses and meet new people from other clubs.

Costs

Entry fees: Nil.

Host clubs will determine green fees, to be paid by the CSGA. Arrangements for lunch will be determined by the host club for each round.

Cheryl Lane Trophy – management of finals

The CSGA Pennant Coordinator will assist with management of the final game. Each player's score will count toward the final team result and the team with the highest aggregate score over the three rounds will be the winner. Should scores be tied at the conclusion of the three rounds a count back will be conducted to determine the winner. The trophy, donated by Cheryl Lane, will be presented to the winning team after conclusion of the final round.

Daily prizes (provided by CSGA)

- \$20 voucher each for the winning team
- \$20 voucher each for the two best stableford scores (excluding winning team)
- Two balls for next five scores and NTP
- One ball for rest of the field.

CSGA representative to ensure prizes are available at the host club on the day.

Team Captain responsibilities

- check GA handicaps for each team member about a day before
- prepare team list (Attachment 2) with GA and daily handicaps, using the Daily Handicap Chart for the 9 holes to be played (this can be done on the day if necessary)
- present list of players to host club at least 30 minutes prior to teeing off.

Host club responsibilities

- ensure tee times are booked to accommodate the number of groups of 4 players
- a few days before each round, send information to participating teams regarding availability of carts and catering arrangements, and provide a Daily Handicap Chart for the 9 holes to be played
- draws for each round to be provided by CSGA – refer sample at Attachment 1
- manage team registration and prepare Starter's List
- manage any claims or disputes that may arise (any claims or disputes will be decided by the match official of the host club)
- record results on team lists and email to the CSGA 9-Hole-Challenge Coordinator (barbara.wallace@outlook.com).
