CSGA FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS TERMS OF THE COMPETITION 2021

- 1. This event is open to all Amateur Women members of any golf club affiliated with GA and clubs recognised by the bodies governing Women's Golf in overseas countries.
- 2. The R&A Rules of Golf 2020 and the Local Rules of the Host Club shall be the rules of play for this competition.
- 3. The Foursomes Championships is a Stroke competition for all Divisions.
- 4. The number of divisions and breakdown will be decided once all entries have been received. Entry fees are not refundable from two days after the closing date.
- 5. There will be set tee times from 10.00am. Presentations for the Foursomes event will be undertaken asap at the end of play.
- 6. A tie in the Foursomes Scratch Champion event (Bridges Cup only) will be decided by a sudden death hole by hole play-off starting from the 1st Hole.
- 7. A tie in the handicap event shall be decided using the GA method of count back.
- 8. Gross will take precedence over nett events, depending on the prize money. Players can only win one prize excluding NTPs.
- 9. The CSGA Match Committee has complete control of this event and reserves the right to vary conditions should it be deemed necessary. The decision of the Match Committee on all points of protest shall be final.
- 10. Competitors must report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled hit off time.
- 11. Motorised Transport is permitted. The CSGA Committee takes no responsibility for the provision of motorised transport and players should make their own arrangements and bookings with the respective Club Pro Shops.

- 12. Mobile phones may be carried on the course if in silent mode. A player may use a Mobile phone for the following uses only (NB: If a phone is used outside of these parameters it will be considered a breach of these conditions):
 - As a distance measuring device. It must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.) otherwise the player will be in breach of Rule 4-3a.
 - To look up the R&A Rules and/or Decisions of Golf
 - To score the match if mi-score is used at the hosting club
 - In case of emergency
- 13. Players should ensure their Pace of Play is in accordance with the 2019 R&A Rules of Golf. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to individuals in such groups, who by their pace contribute to such delay.
- 14. It is the responsibility of the competitor to comply with the dress regulations of the Host Club.
- 15. Players must abide by the R&A Rules of Golf, Rule 1.2 "Standards of Player Conduct".
