## VETERAN'S DAY 2022

### TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. This event is open to all Amateur Golfing Women who are **50 years of age and over** who are members of any golf club affiliated with Golf Australia and clubs recognised by the bodies governing golf in overseas countries.
2. This competition is a **STABLEFORD** event for GA handicaps 0 - 45. If a player has a handicap greater than 45 they will be required to play off a maximum of GA 45 on the day. Competitors **MUST PICK UP** balls when they can no longer score a stableford point.
3. This event is a SHOTGUN start and competitors must report to the starter 30 mins prior to the scheduled hit off time and then make their way to the allocated tee. In accordance with Rule 5.3a, players shall start at the time laid down by the CSGA Match Committee, otherwise it may result in receiving the general penalty.
4. One competition prize only will be awarded per player, apart from an NTP. The number of prizes will be dependent on entry numbers. Ties in all events shall be decided using the GA method of count back (starting with the back 9 Holes 10-18).
5. **Special Event:**  
**The H.K. Smith Trophy** – will be awarded to the player with the best stableford score across all Divisions. This trophy is the major prize and the winner will not be entitled to win any other prize, apart from an NTP.  
**SuperVet winner** (not a trophy event) – will be awarded to the player, who is aged 70 years or older with the best stableford score across all Divisions and who has not already received a prize. A second prize may be awarded to the best player aged 80 and over, if not the SuperVet prize recipient.
6. Divisions for this event will be determined after close of entries on 16th May 2022 at 5pm. Entry fees are not refundable after this date. Should entries exceed course places which are 120 ladies on the day, additional players will be placed on a waiting list through the trybooking system and will be notified if a place becomes available.
7. Golf Link numbers must be supplied on the Trybooking entry form for handicap verification.
8. The R&A Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Host Club shall be the rules of play for this competition.
9. Caddies are not permitted.

10. Motorised Transport is permitted without production of a medical certificate. Bookings must be made direct with the Host Club.
11. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to comply with the dress regulations of the Host Club.
12. Mobile phones may be carried on the course if in the silent mode. A player may use a Mobile phone for the following uses only (NB: If a phone is used outside of these parameters it will be considered a breach of these conditions):
  - As a distance measuring device. It must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.) otherwise the player will be in breach of Rule 4-3a.
  - To look up the R&A Rules and/or Decisions of Golf
  - In case of emergency
13. Players should ensure their Pace of Play is in accordance with the 2019 R&A Rules of Golf. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to individuals in such groups, who by their pace contribute to such delay.
14. Players must abide by the R&A Rules of Golf, Rule 1.2 "Standards of Player Conduct".
15. The CSGA Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the Competition with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions. The CSGA Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the Competition shall be final.
