NB: Divisions are based on daily (playing) handicaps NOT GA Handicaps.

51ST WOMEN'S CHALLENGE BOWL

Conditions

1. Entries must be received by 19 July 2021 and accompanied by payment.
2. Open to Amateur Women Members of any golf club affiliated with Golf Australia.
3. Competitors shall play on current Golf Australia Handicaps.
4. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the local rules of Royal Canberra Golf Club. The Women's Golf Committee of Royal Canberra Golf Club shall decide all disputes. Any protest must be lodged with the Women's Golf Committee on the day of competition. Their decision on the matter shall be final.
5. The event will be run as a shotgun start, with a starting time of 8.30am. In the event of the inability of a nominated player to compete a substitute may be entered.
6. The Women's Golf Committee has the power to make all arrangements and to alter or vary the conditions of the program should they deem it necessary.
7. In the event of inclement weather, the decision to shorten or abandon the competition shall be at the discretion of the Women's Golf Committee. The event might not be rescheduled, if cancellation is necessary.
8. Ties for the Challenge Bowl event will be decided on a count back of the combined three best scores in each team. Combined totals of the last 9, last 6, last 3 and hole by hole.
9. Ties for the individual Stableford events will be decided on a count back.
10. Slow play: Loss of hole - the Women's Golf Committee shall impose a two stroke penalty on each player in that group.
11. Caddies are not permitted. Players must be independent and self sufficient.
12. Cart usage may be limited in severe conditions. **In the event of frost Carts will not be permitted on the course before 10am**
13. Privately owned golf carts, scooters etc are not allowed to be used at Royal Canberra

Dress regulations

1. Tailored pants, three quarter pants and shorts, golf skirts and skorts of an appropriate length.
2. Denim, tight stretch, tracksuit type, stirrup pants and cargo pants are not permitted on the course or in the Clubhouse.
3. Suitable shirts with or without a collar are acceptable and must be tucked into pants unless specifically designed to be worn out.
4. Singlet-type tops, casual T-shirts and garments with advertising or slogans (except for discreet brand name and club logos) are not permitted.
5. Trainers are not permitted in the Members Lounge or Restaurant, however clean golf shoes are permitted in the Members Lounge and on the balcony.
6. Hats or visors must be removed on entering the Clubhouse.
